PENTECOST: COME HOLY SPIRIT 2025

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, this marks fifty days after the resurrection. It was on this day that God the Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. We commemorate this day as the beginning or birthday of the Church. The Apostles had locked themselves up in the room for fear of the Jews, but they were praying with the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Holy Spirit descended upon them giving them the grace and courage to go out and confidently proclaim their faith and announce the good news of Jesus Christ to all. For Christians, Pentecost should be a moment and a celebration of new beginnings, receiving the Holy Spirit should be like getting a new heart and a new life in God, that transforms and empowers us to spontaneously produce good works of God in the world. "Lord, send out your Spirit and renew the face of the earth" Ps.104:30.

The Spirit that came down on the Church at Pentecost came to gather people who had been scattered, so that those who accept the gospel of Christ and open their hearts to the Holy Spirit may speak a new language that everybody understandsthe language of love.
