PRINCIPAL PILLARS OF THE CHURCH

We celebrate the Solemnity of the two great pillars of the Christian Faith, Saint Peter, the first Vicar of the Church and Saint Paul, the great apostle and missionary to the gentiles; they bore witness to Christ with their lives and were martyred in Rome during the reign of Emperor Nero, both men were condemned to death by crucifixion, but tradition has it that Peter was crucified upside-down, he requested for this form of crucifixion because he felt unworthy to be crucified like Jesus Christ his Lord and Master, While Paul who is a Roman citizen was beheaded because death by crucifixion was a typical method for noncitizens. These two men were great, but they were also 'weak;' they were not chosen because they were great but because despite their weaknesses, they had great love for Christ and entrusted themselves totally to Him. So don't be afraid to bear witness to Christ because of your weaknesses. "God chooses the foolish of the world to shame the wise and the weak of the world to shame the strong..." 1Cor.1:27-29.
