THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST: AMEN!

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. This feast is celebrated each year to strengthen our faith, love, devotion, and reverence in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Christ instituted the Holy Eucharist the night before His death to help us remember and celebrate His love for us and His ever abiding presence with us. Whenever we celebrate the Holy Eucharist, we are not just remembering or recalling an event that happened in the past, rather what we are remembering is made real in the present moment. The saving work of Our Lord Jesus Christ is re-presented, made present here and now on our altars. Jesus himself told us that the Holy Eucharist is true food for our nourishment and sustenance. "My Flesh is real food, and my Blood is real drink." Jn.6:55. Catholic tradition teaches us that the Holy Eucharist is indeed seen as "medicine for our souls." It is the "source and summit of our faith." The Holy Eucharist is Jesus himself, the Church teaches that Jesus Christ is present whole and entire, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity under the Eucharistic species of bread and wine. We may not see, feel, or taste the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist; but if we accept with faith, study and pray the teachings of Jesus and His Church the Holy Spirit will lead us to the complete truth about the Holy Eucharist and help us gain a better understanding of what we celebrate and consume.

St Paul in his letter to the Corinthians and us, warns that eating and drinking the Body and Blood of Christ unworthily has serious implications. "Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily will have to answer for the Body and Blood of the Lord. A person should examine himself/herself, before they eat the bread and drink the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the Body, eats and drinks judgement on himself/herself."1Cor. 11:27-31. The Sacrament of Reconciliation offers us perfect opportunities to examine our conscience, repent and make amend before approaching the Eucharist with faith, love, and reverence.

Parish Financial Report

March 31, 2025 was the end of the third quarter of the parish 2025 fiscal year (July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025).

The table below summarizes the parish fiscal year-to-date financial data.

Cumulative expenses for the year continue to be slightly higher than the budget as reported in the first and second quarter financial reports. For the third quarter, expenses were \$14,333 higher than budget.

Cumulative income for the year has also been consistently higher than the budget which has more than covered the increased expenses.
