
PERSEVERANCE IN PRAYER

Today the universal Church celebrates the World Mission Sunday, "a time of prayer and giving to support the missionary work of the Church." With the theme of this year's celebration: "Missionaries of Hope Among All Peoples." The Holy Father, Pope Leo invites all of us to follow in the footsteps of Jesus Christ not as 'a static Church, but a missionary Church that walks with her Lord through the streets of the world' offering support and consolation to those most in need. We are called to generously support the Mission of the Church to the ends of the world by our prayers, by going or giving to the mission.

The reading of this Sunday teaches us important lessons on perseverance in prayer. Jesus taught his disciples and us the need to pray always without becoming weary. In our first reading, Moses with his hands lifted high in prayer won God's attention as He granted victory to the people of Israel over the Amalekites but the moment Moses became weary and lowered his hands the Amalekites began to have an upper hand, Aaron and Hur provided support to Moses and kept his hands up in prayer till sun set and Joshua and the people were victorious in battle against Amalek.


