BLESSED ARE THEY WHO FOLLOW GOD'S LAWS

The main message of this Sunday's readings is centered on the laws of God; the Psalmist proclaims, "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord." Many people are of the opinion that laws are meant to restrict human freedom and deprive them of happiness, but the truth is that the laws of God were given for our own good and for order and harmony in human interactions. The author of the Book of Sirach reminds us that God does not force his laws on humans but has set before us, fire and water, life and death, good and evil and invites us to choose wisely.

St. Matthew presents Jesus as the new Moses, the greatest law giver who has come not to abolish the law or the prophets but to fulfill them and He calls on his followers to a righteousness that surpasses that of the Scribes and the Pharisees. Mtt.5:20. Jesus challenges us with these words: "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors.... But I say this to you..." by so doing He calls us to a greater fidelity to the laws of God, not just at the level of actions but that we also examine our interior dispositions and intentions that are underlying our actions, because it is often within our desires, thoughts and feelings that most sins and evil are conceived before they come to fruition.

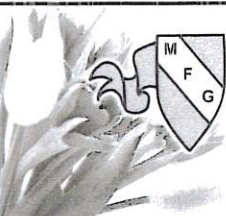
