THE MYSTERY OF THE TRINITY

The readings for Year A — Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9; Daniel 3:52-56; 2 Corinthians 13:11-13; John 3:16-18 — point us to God's nature. In Exodus, God reveals Himself as merciful, just, and faithful; in Daniel, His holiness and rule over all creation are praised; in 2 Corinthians, Paul calls for peace and unity in the Spirit; and in John, Jesus proclaims that God's love is so great that He sent His Son for salvation. Together, they reveal the Trinity as a communion of love, not a mere philosophical concept, but the very face of God walking with humanity.

Pope Francis reminds us that "God is love" — a love that is not sentimental but the origin of all life, expressed in the Father's giving, the Son's sacrifice, and the Spirit's renewal. This love calls us to love others as Jesus loved us, to give ourselves freely, and to walk with Him in daily life.

The Trinity Sunday challenge is to **trust the mystery** and live in peace and unity with others. We are called to: **Communion:** Reflect on the unity of the three Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — and how they work together in our lives. **Service:** Let the love of the Trinity inspire acts of mercy, justice, and reconciliation. **Prayer:** Make the Sign of the Cross slowly, meditating on each Person of the Trinity. **The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity** is not about explaining the mystery but about **entering into the embrace of God's communion**. As we celebrate, let us be drawn deeper into the love of the Father, the saving love of the Son, and the guiding **love** of the Holy Spirit — and let that love transform our relationships and our world.

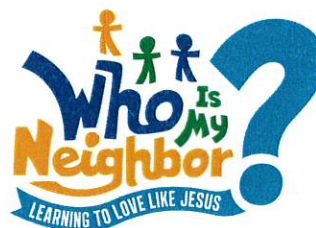
Young Adult Bible Study (18–35-year-olds) will be held on Monday, June 1 from 6-8 pm in the conference room.
