True Living Bread Divine

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday, is a feast of profound thanksgiving and devotion. It is a “three-in-one” celebration: the Eucharistic sacrifice, the sacrament of the Eucharist, and the Real Presence of Jesus.

In the Eucharist, the bread and wine are transformed into the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. This is not merely symbolic; it is the same sacrifice made on the Cross, made present in every Mass. St. Mark's words – “This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many” – point to the eternal covenant between God and humanity, made possible through Christ's one sacrifice.

The Eucharist is both a banquet and a sacrifice. It nourishes our souls, strengthens our union with God, and unites us with one another as members of His Body. St. Thomas Aquinas called it “true living Bread divine,” sustaining us for eternal life. St. Josemaría saw it as a miracle of love that lasts forever, offering Christ Himself as food and drink for His children.

The value of the Eucharist is infinite. No earthly wealth can compare to its worth, and no amount of money can buy happiness or Heaven – but the Eucharist bestows both freely. Those who receive it faithfully are transformed into members of Christ's Body, destined for eternal life.

The feast reminds us to reverence Christ in the Eucharist, the only place where He is present in a visible form. It calls us to appreciate this gift, to make it a central part of our lives, and to live in gratitude for His sacrifice and love. As Msgr. Dolan noted, the Blessed Sacrament is “a greater work of art than anything else in St. Peter's Basilica” – a living, visible presence of God.

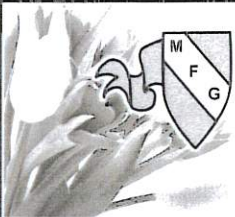
