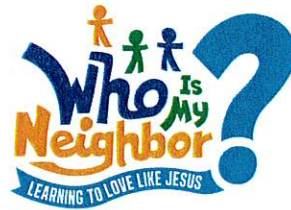
Young Adult Bible Study (18-35-year-olds) will be held on Monday, June 29 from 6-8 pm in the conference room.
